(PONTARDAWE REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE 2025)
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES)
ORDER 2025

WHEREAS the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (“the Council”) being the Traffic Authority is satisfied that various roads in Neath should be temporarily closed to vehicular traffic in order to enable the Pontardawe Remembrance Day Parade 2025 to take place on those roads.

NOW therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation 1984 (as amended) and Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Whilst the Order is in force, subject to the proviso set out in clause 2 below, vehicular traffic are prohibited from driving along the streets as set out in the Schedule below in order to enable the Pontardawe Remembrance Day Parade 2025 to take place.
2. The restriction in Clause 1 above shall not apply to the following vehicles:-
 - Police and Emergency vehicles
3. This Order will be in force between 9.30am and 12.30pm on Sunday 9th November 2025.
4. This Order may be cited as “The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Pontardawe Remembrance Day Parade) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2025.

SCHEDULE

Herbert Street, Pontardawe

From its junction with A474 Swansea Road to its junction with Tawe Terrace a distance of approximately 467 metres.

Holly Street, Pontardawe

From its junction with Herbert Street to its junction with Tawe Terrace a distance of approximately 108 metres..
