(TEMPORARY NO WAITING, LOADING OR UNLOADING AT ANY
TIME ORDER]
ORDER 2025

WHEREAS the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (“the Council”) being the Traffic Authority for Margam Road, Margam is satisfied that traffic restrictions should be put in place on the road to enable the filming of ‘The Rapture’ tv production to take place on the road.

NOW therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Whilst the Order is in force, subject to the proviso set out in clause 2 below, vehicular traffic is prohibited from waiting, loading or unloading at any time along the length of side of road set out in the Schedule below in order to enable filming of ‘The Rapture’ tv production to take place.
2. The restriction in Clause 1 above shall not apply to the following vehicles:-
 - ‘The Rapture’ tv production company vehicles
 - Police and Emergency Services Vehicles
3. This Order will be in force between the hours of 6.30am to 7.30pm on Thursday 9th October 2025.
4. This Order may be cited as “The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (‘The Rapture’ Filming, Margam Road, Margam) (Temporary No Waiting, Loading Or Unloading At Any Time) Order 2025.

SCHEDULE

A48 Margam Road, Margam [West Side]

From a point situated approximately 6 metres south of its junction with the southern kerbline of Stallcourt Close for a distance of approximately 120 metres along its length in a southerly direction.
