ORDER 2025

NOTICE is given that the Council on the 14th day of May 2025 made an Order in pursuance of its powers as contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is as set out in the Schedules below.

The Order will come into force on the 23rd May 2025.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its powers on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made apply for that purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULES

Schedule 1 - Revocation

- 1.1 Any existing Orders are hereby revoked only in so far as they relate to the sides and lengths of roads set out in the Schedules below.

Schedule 2 - Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading at Any Time

2.1 B4603 Ynysmeudwy Road, Pontardawe (South West Side)

From a point approximately 116 metres south west of a point opposite and in line with the western kerbline of Clos Nant Ddu to a point approximately 125 metres south west of a point opposite and in line with the western kerbline of Clos Nant Ddu, a distance of approximately 9 metres in a south westerly direction

2.2 B4603 Ynysmeudwy Road, Pontardawe (South West Side)

From a point approximately 71 metres south west of a point opposite and in line with the western kerbline of Clos Nant Ddu to a point approximately 100 metres south west of a point opposite and in line with the western kerbline of Clos Nant Ddu, a distance of approximately 25 metres in a south westerly direction
