**(‘THE RAPTURE’ FILMING – STALLCOURT CLOSE AND MARGAM**  
**ROAD REAR LANE, MARGAM)**  
**(SPECIAL EVENT TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES)**  
**ORDER 2025**

**WHEREAS** the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (“the Council”) being the Traffic Authority is satisfied that various roads in Margam should be temporarily closed to vehicular traffic in order to enable the filming of the ‘The Rapture’ tv production to take place on the roads.

**NOW** therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. Whilst the Order is in force, subject to the proviso set out in clause 2 below, vehicular traffic are prohibited from driving along the streets as set out in the Schedule below in order to enable filming of ‘The Rapture’ tv production to take place.
2. The restriction in Clause 1 above shall not apply to the following vehicles:-
  - Residents’ vehicles
  - ‘The Rapture’ tv production company’s vehicles
  - Police and Emergency Services vehicles
3. This Order will be in force from 6.30am to 7.30pm on Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> October 2025.
4. This Order may be cited as “The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (‘The Rapture’ filming, Stallcourt Close and Margam Road Rear Lane, Margam) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2025.

## SCHEDULE

### Stallcourt Close, Margam

From its junction with Margam Road along its entire length, a distance of approximately 82 metres in a south westerly direction.

### Lane to the rear of 182 to 198 Margam Road, Margam

From its junction with Stallcourt Close to its junction with Graig Avenue.
