(VARIOUS ROADS IN MARGAM)
(TEMPORARY NO WAITING, LOADING OR UNLOADING AT ANY TIME)
ORDER 2026

NOTICE is hereby given that the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (“the Council”) being the Traffic Authority for the County Borough is satisfied that certain roads in Margam should temporarily be subject to No Waiting, Loading or Unloading At Any Time restrictions, in order to prevent indiscriminate parking of vehicles on those roads in the interest of road safety whilst the IN IT TOGETHER FESTIVAL 2026 takes place in the vicinity of those roads.

Therefore the Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and of all other enabling powers has made an Order the effect of which is as follows:

1. Whilst the Order is in force, save as provided in point 2 below, no person shall except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to Wait, Load or Unload At Any Time on the lengths of carriageways, and/or on the adjacent footways and highway verges of the roads set out in the Schedule below
2. The prohibition in point 1 above shall not apply to :-
 - a. any vehicle stopping in order to enable a person to board or alight from that vehicle
 - b. any vehicle being used at the time for any building, industrial or demolition works being carried out on any land adjacent to these roads
 - c. any vehicle being used at the time by the emergency services for the purposes of carrying out their functions
 - d. any vehicle being used by the local authority for carrying out its functions on or adjacent to these roads
 - e. any vehicle being used by a statutory undertaker whilst carrying out its functions on or adjacent to these roads
 - f. any Universal Service Provider’s vehicle for the purpose of collecting or delivering postal packets/parcels from premises adjacent to these roads.
3. Whilst this order is in force, the South Wales Police Constabulary are authorised
 - a. to direct any vehicular traffic which are in breach of the provisions of the Order to vacate any part of the carriageways, footways or highway verges of the roads set out in the Schedule below

AND/OR

- b. to remove any vehicles which are in breach of the provisions of the Order, by such means of removal as the Police deem appropriate, from those roads set out in the Schedule below (e.g. by towing away of vehicles).
4. The Order will be in force from 2pm on Wednesday 20th May 2026 until 4pm on Monday 25th May 2026.

SCHEDULE

A48 from Margam roundabout to Pyle Road, Margam (Both Sides)

From a point approximately 10 metres north west of its junction with Ten Acre Wood for a distance of approximately 4390 metres in a generally south easterly direction.

B4283 Water Street, Margam (Both Sides)

From its junction with the A48 Margam for a distance of approximately 2880 metres in a generally southerly direction.

Ten Acre Wood, Margam (Both Sides)

From its entire length

Margam Orangery Access Lane, Margam (Both Sides)

From its junction with Ten Acre wood for a distance of approximately 100 metres in a generally north easterly direction.

Margam Park Access Road, Margam (Both Sides)

From its junction with A48 from Margam roundabout to Pyle Road for a distance of approximately 25 metres in a generally north easterly direction.

Margam Park Access Lanes, Margam (Both Sides)

From its junction with A48 from Margam roundabout to Pyle Road for a distance of approximately 410 metres in a generally north easterly direction then northerly and then westerly direction.

Cwm Cadno, Coed Hirwaun, Margam (Both Sides)

From its junction with A48 from Margam roundabout to Pyle Road for a distance of approximately 475 metres in a generally north easterly direction.

Ffordd Derwen, Coed Hirwaun, Margam (Both Sides)

From its junction with Cwm Cadno for a distance of approximately 80 metres in a generally south easterly direction.
