

# Issue of a Flood Warning for the River Neath at Aberdulais - Flooding is expected. Immediate action required.

FIDO contact FWDO to assess weather conditions.

If local situation requires Emergency Response, e.g. tree blockages anticipated, FIDO to dispatch Ops team to site.

Site Controller (NRW) to remain on site and monitor until safe levels achieved - contact personnel from other partner agencies as appropriate to provide updates.

Flood Warning for Aberdulais received via NRW Flood Warning Service (text, email and phone). For further info contact Flood Incident Room at Haverfordwest via direct line.

Depending on the information given by NRW, EPDO to request dispatch of NPT Highways operational personnel to make contact with NRW on site.

Flood Warning for Aberdulais received via NRW Flood Warning Service (text, email and phone to Fire Control Room).

This will be allocated an incident reference number. Details will be forwarded to local officers and stations.

For further info contact Flood Incident Room at Haverfordwest via direct line.

Flood Warning for Aberdulais received via NRW Flood Warning Service (text, email and phone to FIM). This will be allocated an incident reference number. Details will be forwarded to local officers and stations.

FIM to dispatch Police representative to site to make personal contact with NRW on site.

Notify NPTCBC when SWP officers are on site. For further info contact Flood Incident Room at Haverfordwest via direct line.

Forecast worsening situation - i.e. river levels rising significantly above Flood Warning level. Possibility of reaching next level e.g. Pontneddfechan and Cilfrew river gauges continuing to rise.

POLICE ESTABLISH BRONZE MULTI-AGENCY CONTROL AT SITE - FORWARD CONTROL POINT - location to be determined (see pages 3+4 for potential sites). NRW, SWP, M&WWF&RS and NPTCBC in attendance.

If available, sandbags to protect property in Canal Side. Calor Gas and the Railway Tayern from localised flood sources (front and back of properties). For information: Lowest lying properties are at south-westerly end of Canal Side (house no. 30) **Advise Forward Control Point of** forecast situation after liaising with Flood Operational Response Centres in SW Area.

FWDO / FIDO to advise NPTCBC **Emergency Planning Duty Officer,** MWWFRS and SWP of the worsening situation.

Highways (via on site Highways Officer) to place appropriate road signage and traffic cones at:

- Canal Side
- Station Road
- Dulais Fach Road / Tonna Uchfa Road
- Mini roundabout / B4434 slip road.
- On site Highways Officer to also inform a more senior officer of the situation

EPDO, following advice from NRW / M&WWF&RS / SWP, will place on standby:

- Rest Centre key holders & Social Services: Neath Sports Centre / Vale of Neath Leisure Centre / Pontardawe Leisure Centre
- Voluntary Organisations
- Passenger Transport (contractors)

M&WWF&RS will respond to emergency calls as they occur and allocate resources as required, and will inform other agencies if necessary.

**Notify NPTCBC** if M&WWF&RS officers are on site.

FIM to inform relevant SWP officers / stations. NRW and **NPTCBC EPDO** of worsening situation.

#### **SWP actions:**

- Management of Public / Safety.
- Members of the public to be excluded from area overlooking the River Neath in the car park / canal take-off area.
- Traffic Management.
- Liaise with residents of Canal. Side

# Consider issu Severe Flood Warning (multi-agency)

**FWDO** to liaise with **Site Controller** (**NRW**) with respect to exact levels and potential for severe impact being realised.

If time allows, **DTM** to discuss with Duty Officers from **SWP**, **M&WWF&RS** and **NPTCBC** about the implications of the issue of Severe Flood Warning and actions for consideration.

If rapid escalation of levels to SFW threshold preclude a MA discussion, **DTM** to instruct **FWDO** to issue Severe Flood Warning. **DTM** should then contact Duty Officers from **SWP**, **M&WWF&RS** and **NPTCBC** about the implications of the issue of Severe Flood Warning.

Highways Duty Officer and EPDO to participate in discussions with NRW, M&WWF&RS and SWP concerning the issuing of the Severe Flood Warning, and if required – EPDO to activate rest centre, social services, transport following multiagency discussions / decisions.

**NB:** the provision of local authority sourced transport can be in excess of one hour

If required, **M&WWF&RS** to participate in discussions with **NRW**, **SWP** and **NPTCBC** concerning the issuing of the Severe Flood Warning.

M&WWF&RS will respond to emergency calls as they occur and allocate resources as required, and will inform other agencies if necessary.

**Notify NPTCBC** if M&WWF&RS officers are on site.

**SWP** to participate in discussions with **NRW**, **M&WWF&RS** and **NPTCBC** concerning the issuing of the Severe Flood Warning.

Advise SWP representative on site of the evacuation.

Consider advising residents of situation and possible evacuation following multi-agency discussions / joint decisions.

Telecon: Multi-agency considerations - Activation of rest centre

**Telecon: Multi-agency considerations - Evacuation of residents to rest centre** 



Issue of a Severe Flood Warning for the River Neath at Aberdulais – Severe flooding. Danger to life.

All agencies to consider whether a major incident should be declared for their agency, if so, inform all over responding agencies.

Evacuate all NRW personnel from Canal take-off area, and from behind walls adjacent to River Neath and Social Club.

Liaise with forecaster with regard to forecast conditions and expected impact.

Manage local situation from safe area.

**NPT Highways** to remain on site to provide support to emergency services / NRW, continue assisting with road closures etc.

**Social Services** staff to attend and manage rest centre. If necessary also arrange for catering and emergency housing.

**Transport** to collect evacuees from Forward Control Point and transport to rest centre. **EPDO** to remain available in the event of further issues / escalation.

M&WWF&RS will respond to emergency calls as they occur and allocate resources as required, and will inform other agencies if necessary.

Notify NPTCBC if M&WWF&RS officers are on site.

The most relevant organisation will take primacy over this incident. This will be decided by Commanders at the scene.

Commence evacuation of Canal Side by order starting lower area (down-stream side, from house no. 30).

Establish security of property, where possible and safe to do so.

**Health and safety:** Consider the safety of responders **jointly** – NRW to advise other responders if the site is becoming increasingly dangerous due to flooding. If the site has become dangerous, evacuate personnel to the **Forward Control Point** (B4434 Mini Roundabout, access to A465).

#### Additional Information:

During periods of high river flow, the Tennant Canal Company may restrict flow into the canal by closing down the take-off valves at Canal Side and also open sluices downstream to reduce levels in the canal itself.
