The Order is necessary to prevent indiscriminate parking in the interest of road safety.

SCHEDULES

<u>Schedule 1 – Revocation of Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time – Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Ystalyfera - Traffic Management) Order 1998</u>

1.1 Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From a point in line with the northern kerbline of Gurnos Road for a distance of approximately 50 metres in a south westerly direction.

1.2 <u>Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)</u>

From a point in line with the south-east kerbline of Tirbach Road for a distance of approximately 35 metres in a north easterly direction.

1.3 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From a point approximately 23 metres southwest of the south western kerbline of Allt-y-Grug Road for a distance of approximately 35 metres in a south westerly direction.

<u>Schedule 2 – Revocation of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm 30 minutes</u> <u>Loading only - Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Various Places)</u> (Loading Only) Order 2007

2.1 <u>Loading Only, Maximum Duration 30 Minutes Monday to Saturday</u> 8am-6pm Wern Road, Ystalyfera – South East Side

Between points approximately 60 metres and 70 metres south west of its junction with Darren Road.

Schedule 3 – Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time

3.1 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From a point approximately 23 metres southwest of its junction with the south western kerbline of Allt-y-Grug Road to a point approximately 75 metres southwest of its junction with the south western kerbline of Allt-y-Grug, for a distance of approximately 52 metres in a south westerly direction.

3.2 Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From its junction with the south eastern kerbline of Tirbach Road to its junction with the north western kerbline of Gurnos Road for a distance of approximately 200 metres in a north easterly direction.

Schedule 4 – Prohibition of Waiting, Loading or Unloading at Any Time

4.1 <u>Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)</u>

From a point approximately 85 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerbline of Old Wern Road for a distance of approximately 10 metres in a north easterly direction.

4.2 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)

From its junction with the north western kerbline of Zoar Road for a distance of approximately 30 metres in a north easterly direction.

4.3 Zoar Road, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From its junction with the south eastern kerbline of Wern Road for a distance of approximately 5 metres in a south easterly direction.

<u>Schedule 5 – Loading Only 30 minutes Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm</u>

5.1 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)

From a point approximately 70 metres southwest of its junction with the western kerbline of Darren Road for a distance of approximately 6 metres in a south westerly direction.

<u>Schedule 6 – Limited Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm 1 hour Noreturn within 1 hour</u>

6.1 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)

From a point approximately 76 metres south west of its junction with the western kerbline of Darren Road for a distance of approximately 14 metres in a south westerly direction.

ORDER 2025

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into force on the day of 2025 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Commercial Street, Wern Road and Zoar Road, Ystalyfera) (Revocation) (No Waiting at any Time) (No Waiting, Loading or Unloading at any Time) (Loading Only) and (Limited Waiting) Order 2025".
- 2. (1) In this Order –

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) (Amended) Regulations 2000;

"Relevant Position" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) (Amended) Regulations 2000";

"Public Service Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 and "local service" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Transport Act 1985;

- "Universal Providers" means those operators of postal services who are licensed to provide all or part of a Universal Postal Service under the provisions contained in the Postal Services Act 2000.
- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The provisions contained in the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Ystalyfera Traffic Management) Order 1998 are hereby revoked only in so far as set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 4. The provisions contained in the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Various Places) (Loading Only) Order 2007 are hereby revoked only in so far as set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 10, 11, 12 and 13 of this Order no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of sides of road as set out in the Schedule 3 to this Order
- 6. Save as provided in Articles 11 and 13 and of this Order, no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the lengths of sides of roads set out in Schedule 4 of this Order.
- 7. (1) The Loading Bay as set out in the Schedule 5 of this Order is designated as a parking place between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Saturday for goods vehicles which are being loaded or unloaded only.
 - (2) Save as provided by Articles 11 and 13 of this Order no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle (including a Disabled Persons Vehicle) to use the Loading Bay referred to in Article 7 (1) above other than for the purpose of loading or unloading goods vehicles for a period of no more than 30 minutes.
- 8. Save as provided in Articles 9, 11, 12 and 13 of this Order, no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait for more than 1 hour or to return within 1 hour to the same length of side of road on which that period of waiting began between the hours of 8am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday on the length of side of roads set out in Schedule 6 to this Order.
- 9. Nothing in Article 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge to wait on the length of side of road referred to in the said Article.
- 10. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a Disabled Person's Vehicle which displays in the relevant position a Disabled Person's Badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the lengths of sides of roads referred to in the Article for a period not

- exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same length of side of road on which that vehicle had previously been waiting).
- 11. Nothing in Article 5, 6, 7 (2) and 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the length of side of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable: -
 - (A) A person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (B) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely: -
 - (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of sides of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (C) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (D) The vehicle to be used by a Universal Service Provider for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
 - (E) Public Service Vehicles operating a local service when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers, or to school buses;
 - (F) The vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
- 12. Nothing in Article 5 and 8 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the length of side of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded and unloaded from the vehicle.
- 13. The prohibitions imposed by Articles 5, 6, 7 (2) and 8 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.

Schedule 2 – Revocation of Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm 30 minutes Loading only - Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Various Places) (Loading Only) Order 2007

2.1 <u>Loading Only, Maximum Duration 30 Minutes Monday to Saturday 8am-6pm Wern Road, Ystalyfera – South East Side</u>

Between points approximately 60 metres and 70 metres south west of its junction with Darren Road.

Schedule 3 – Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time

3.1 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From a point approximately 23 metres southwest of its junction with the south western kerbline of Allt-y-Grug Road to a point approximately 75 metres southwest of its junction with the south western kerbline of Allt-y-Grug, for a distance of approximately 52 metres in a south westerly direction.

3.2 Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From its junction with the south eastern kerbline of Tirbach Road to its junction with the north western kerbline of Gurnos Road for a distance of approximately 200 metres in a north easterly direction.

Schedule 4 - Prohibition of Waiting, Loading or Unloading at Any Time

4.1 <u>Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)</u>

From a point approximately 85 metres north east of its junction with the north eastern kerbline of Old Wern Road for a distance of approximately 10 metres in a north easterly direction.

4.2 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)

From its junction with the north western kerbline of Zoar Road for a distance of approximately 30 metres in a north easterly direction.

4.3 Zoar Road, Ystalyfera (North-West Side)

From its junction with the south eastern kerbline of Wern Road for a distance of approximately 5 metres in a south easterly direction.

<u>Schedule 5 – Loading Only 30 minutes Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm</u>

5.1 Wern Road, Ystalyfera (South-East Side)

From a point approximately 70 metres southwest of its junction with the western kerbline of Darren Road for a distance of approximately 6 metres in a south westerly direction.
