ORDER 2026

NOTICE is given that the Council on the 26th March 2026 made an Order in pursuance of its powers as contained in Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which is as set out in the Schedule below.

The Order will come into force on the 6th April 2026.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of its powers on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for that purpose to the High Court.

Schedule 1 – Revocation of 30 MPH Speed Limit

(A474 NEW ROAD, GELLINUDD) (REVOCATION) AND (30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2023

1.1 A474 New Road, Gellinudd

From its junction with Pen Yr Alltwen for a distance of approximately 182 metres in a northerly direction.

For clarification the aforementioned section of road will now default to a restricted road status of 20mph by virtue of street lighting.

ORDER 2026

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of April 2026 and may be cited as the “Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (A474 New Road, Gellinudd) (Revocation of 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2026”.
2. (1) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
(2) The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The provisions contained in Schedule 1 of the Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (A474 New Road, Gellinudd) (Revocation) and (30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2023 are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
